Designed to showcase student creativity and the arts, this year's exhibition is a call for one-of-a-kind postcard designs illustrating 'what does America's newest national park - the New River Gorge National Park & Preserve - mean to you?' Selected postcard artwork will later be used by the Department of Tourism to personally invite travelers to Almost Heaven.

CONTEST GUIDELINES

- · The exhibition is open to all West Virginia students grades K through 12. This is to include public, private and home school students.
- A variety of two dimensional submission types will be accepted, including painting, print making, digital art, drawing, photography and mixed media.

ENTRY CHECKLIST

- o Artwork must be no larger than 11" W x 6" H and weigh no more than 3 pounds.
- o Artwork must be matted no larger than 12". If artwork is sent in framed, it must have the ability to hang on display.
- o All submissions must include a completed and signed entry form (see below).
- o Students under the age of 18 must have a parent or guardian sign the form.
- o All submissions must be marked with a copy of the completed entry form on the back of the artwork.
- o A second, unattached copy of the entry form must be included with every submission.
