



Department of Arts, Culture and History – State Historic Preservation Office Awards

In recognition of historic preservation efforts across West Virginia, the following awards will be presented on October 9, 2022 at West Virginia Independence Hall. Recommendations by application will be accepted until **September 15, 2022**.

Betty Woods “Snookie” Nutting Award:

Named after Ms. Nutting for her lifelong pursuit of historic preservation in her hometown of Wheeling and statewide, this award will be presented to an individual who demonstrates a lifetime commitment to historic preservation and has made a recognizable difference in his or her community and across the state through volunteer efforts with organizations such as the local historic landmark commission or historic preservation non-profit organization.

Individual Resource:

Two awards will recognize historic preservation efforts associated with an individual historic resource listed in the National Register of Historic Places:

1. An individual person who demonstrates dedication to historic preservation associated with an individual historic resource.
2. An individual resource which represents a significant aspect of West Virginia's history.

“Historic District” Award:

Two awards will recognize historic preservation efforts associated with historic resources such as an historic district, rural landscape, or battlefield.

1. An organization which has demonstrated a significant contribution to historic preservation.
2. An historic resource that is comprised of multiple components, e.g. historic district, landscape, battlefield, or other resource, that demonstrates a significant aspect of West Virginia's history.
