

# West Virginia Marching Band Invitational Governor's Cup Marching Band Series 2022

Dear Band Director,

Hello, my name is Randall Reid-Smith, and I am contacting you on behalf of the West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History (WVDACH). Along with hosting the eleventh annual West Virginia Marching Band Invitational (WVMBI) this season, WVDACH is sponsoring the Governor's Cup Marching Band Series again. This series will help promote the department's educational Save The Music Foundation program, which provides free musical instruments to middle schools throughout our state. The series will also allow us to award prize money to high school bands.

This marching band season, as we continue to come out of the pandemic, we will again work with local band competitions to promote a Governor's Cup Series. The WVDACH will present \$1000.00 in cash prizes to the top West Virginia bands at a series of local marching band competitions throughout the state. Participating local competitions are:

- September 10, 2022 – John Marshall High School “John Marshall High School Marching Band Showcase”
- September 17, 2022 – Cabell Midland High School “A Knight at the Round Table”
- September 24, 2022 - (Morning) Hurricane High School “Whirlwind of Music”
- September 24, 2022 – (Afternoon/Evening) Poca High School “Heritage Day Festival”
- October 1, 2022 (Morning) – Wyoming East High School “Warrior Classic”
- October 1, 2022 (Afternoon/Evening) – Princeton Senior High School “Southern Thunder”
- October 8, 2022 (Morning) – Parkersburg South High School “Patriot Invitational”
- October 8, 2022 (Afternoon/Evening) – Parkersburg High School “PHS Jim Kessell Marching Band Festival”
- October 15, 2022 (Morning) - Greenbrier East High School “Spartan Classic”
- October 15, 2022 (Afternoon) - Musselman High School “Big Apple Marching Band Festival”
- October 22, 2022 - (Morning) Buckhannon-Upshur High School “Buccaneer Marching Band Festival”
- October 22, 2022 - (Afternoon/Evening) Philip Barbour High School “Horseshoe Classic”
- October 29, 2022 – (ALL DAY) Charleston – The West Virginia Marching Band Invitational and the Governor's Cup Series Finals

We will provide \$1000.00 per contest to award to the top West Virginia bands at each contest, and bands will collect points toward winning the Governor's Cup.

- \$300.00 – Grand Champion – 5 points toward overall Governor's Cup standings
- \$200.00 – 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-Up – 4 points toward overall Governor's Cup standings
- \$100.00 – 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-Up – 3 points toward overall Governor's Cup standings
- 3<sup>rd</sup> Runner-Up – 2 points toward overall Governor's Cup standings
- 4<sup>th</sup> Runner-Up – 1 point toward overall Governor's Cup standings

- \$100.00 – Each class champion – A, B, C, D classes – 1 point towards overall Governor’s Cup Standing

Band Class sizes are as follows:

- Class D - 1-25 playing members
- Class C - 26-45 playing members
- Class B - 46-70 playing members
- Class A - 71 and above playing members

Bands will need to compete in at least **four** local competitions, plus the West Virginia Marching Band Invitational Championships and Governor’s Cup Series finals on October 29th at Laidley Field in Charleston. If a band competes in more than four local contests, their best four scores will be used for final calculations plus their score at the WVMBI. Each host band is eligible at their own competitions to be scored and awarded points toward the Governor’s Cup. Governor’s Cup finals award money:

- \$3250.00 – Governor’s Cup Grand Champion
- \$2000.00 – Governor’s Cup 1<sup>st</sup> Runner-Up
- \$1000.00 – Governor’s Cup 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner-Up
- \$ 750.00 – Governor’s Cup 3<sup>rd</sup> Runner-Up
- \$ 500.00 – Governor’s Cup 4<sup>th</sup> Runner-Up

All West Virginia high school marching bands are invited to apply to participate in the Governor’s Cup Series competitions, as well as the West Virginia State High School Marching Band Invitational.

WVDACH is very excited about WVMBI State Competition and the Governor’s Cup Series. Our hope is to assist in awarding funds to help with success in promoting marching bands in West Virginia.
