Amended Items in Nomination:

This SLR is issued to clarify the status of 1 building within the boundaries of the Lewisburg Historic District, which was listed in the NRHP on July 7, 1985.

The building located at 951 W. Washington Street is identified as a "neutral" property on the resource map included in the nomination. The building, which dates to 1903, was covered in stucco c. 1935. The district nomination, which was submitted in 1978, has no defined period of significance. While the default "50 year cutoff" would be 1928, it is clear that the intended end of the period of significance would end in the mid-1930s (see resource #65, the 1930s Hogg House noted as "pivotal"). The Old Hardware Building does not detract from the streetscape and historically is associated with the theme of the nomination.

This SLR confirms that 951 W. Washington St. is considered a **contributing** building.
