EXHIBITION SALES

A 30% commission will be charged on sales of works from the exhibition. The prices listed on the Entry Form must include a 30% commission for the West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History. Please round prices to the nearest full dollar amount or designate a submission not for sale with 'NFS' followed by an insurance value. Sales are handled by the West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History. Works may not be removed from exhibition before the closing date of show.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

ENTRY FORM ON REVERSE SIDE, CUT OUT TO SUBMIT WITH IMAGES

ELIGIBILITY

- Entries should be made within the past two years and not exceed 7ft in any dimension.
- Unfortunately, film/video works are not eligible for this exhibition.
- Entrants must be over the age of 18 and a current resident of West Virginia. Exceptions may be made for students and active military personnel with resident status and a home address within the state.
- Entrants must be registered in the Artists' Register by entry submission deadline. Contact the Museum Operations Manager, Chuck Ocheltree for more information at 304.558.0220 ext.131 or Charles.C.Ocheltree@wv.gov for more information or to request an Artists' Register form.
- Member's of the West Virginia Commission on the Arts and the Archives and History Commission, as well as employees of the West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History and their families are not eligible.

SUBMISSION OF ENTRIES

Artists can enter up to two pieces in EACH of the four exhibitions. Jurying will be based upon the digital images submitted. Only those submissions selected for exhibition are required to be shipped/delivered to the Culture Center. The juror has the authority to decide what constitutes an acceptable entry. All entries must be structurally sound, appear as they are represented in submitted images, and ready to hang/display. The West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History reserves the right to make the final decision on acceptance based upon condition, presentation, and or faithfulness to the submission images.

INSURANCE/LIABILITY

The West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History will insure all works accepted for exhibition. The inclusive dates of coverage are from time of receipt through final pickup or return shipping. No works will be insured over \$10,000. Works accepted for exhibition that are unstable or may not hold up to the rigors of public presentation may require a waiver of insurance. All claims must be made to the Department within two weeks of receiving damaged works. The West Virginia Department of Arts, Culture and History reserves the right to photograph all works for archival and/or publicity purposes.

IMAGE GUIDELINES

Each entry can have a maximum of **THREE** images submitted. Images must be labeled with last name and corresponding entry number on the entry form. For example, if Jane Doe enters two submissions with three images for the first and two for the second their images would be labeled as followed: DoeEntry1a, DoeEntry1b, DoeEntry1c, DoeEntry2a, DoeEntry2b.

Images can be framed by a black border around the image or include the physical framing in the image. Most submissions include at least one full view of the piece and one or two detail shots. Images **MUST** represent the physical work faithfully. Images that are altered with additional text or multiple photos within one image file will be rejected.

Images should be formatted no larger than 4000 pixels in any direction and no more than 4MB per file. Files should be either JPEG or TIFF, **no other format will be accepted.**

Images and forms may be mailed or delivered to the Culture Center on either a CD or USB, or emailed to Charles.C.Ocheltree@wv.gov. Email submission is preferred and encouraged.
